How to prepare and present the lesson

Below are some tips on how to go about preparing and presenting the lesson:

Step	Action
1	<p>Access the New Apostolic Church Website by keying-in or clicking on the following link from WhatsApp:</p> <p><a href="https://bit.ly/3NACSSHS">https://bit.ly/3NACSSHS</a></p>
2	<p>Gather the following tools to ensure that you are ready for the lesson:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bible</li> <li>• The lesson in PDF format that is already prepared</li> <li>• Child’s workbook and pencils, crayons, etc.</li> <li>• The Video Clip which is an additional/ optional resource tool</li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <p>2.1: An ideal time preferably to present the lesson is after the Sunday morning service in line with the normal Sunday School time to maintain the routine.</p> <p>2.2: Please keep the lesson as concise (brief) as possible, bearing in mind the attention span (to focus on the lesson) of our children - you know your child best! <i>Sunday School normally does not exceed 45 minutes.</i></p> <p>2.3: The lesson is class specific (Sunday School 1).</p> <p>2.4: Please contact your SS 1 Teacher if you need any assistance or if you need any of the above resources.</p>
3	<p>Pray (see the prayer at the end of this document) and ask God to use you as a tool to present the lesson the way He would want us to present it.</p>



## Present a SS 1 Lesson at Home

### How to prepare and present the lesson

We continue to share some tips on how to go about preparing and presenting the lesson:

Step	Action
4	Create a pleasant, disturbance free learning environment where you and the child/ren are at the same level. <b>Example:</b> Sit on a mat or around a table.
5	Read through the lesson. Re-read the lesson so that you understand it. Watch the video-clip of the lesson to get a better understanding of the lesson.
6	Make notes for yourself on important points that you would like to remember.
7	Understand the objective of the lesson that your child must remember.
8	Present the lesson to your child.
9	Show your child the video and recap on the meaning.
10	Refer your child to the activity in the child's workbook (Come Lord Jesus, volume 1)
11	Pray, or ask your child to pray and close the lesson.

### Available tools in terms of Home Schooling

Herewith some tools to enhance the quality of the lesson:

1. WhatsApp chat the lesson with another SS 1 family.
2. Discuss the lesson with other parents to obtain clarity regarding the lesson before it is presented.

## The Lesson

### Lesson Title

How children pray

### Lesson Objective

The objective of this lesson is that the children learn that their prayer is answered by God when they pray to him with trust and belief

### Lesson Summary:

- When Rita got injured and taken to hospital, her parents were very worried.
- They prayed to God for help and they phoned their priest for support and comfort and to join them in prayer
- Before Rita's operation, the priest, congregation, and family prayed to God for His help. They trust in God and believed that He could answer their prayers.
- Always remember that we have a "Heavenly telephone" line with God and it is always available. This is our prayer-connection with God.

### What does this lesson mean for us today?

We always trust and belief in God and feel comforted when He answers our prayers.

### Some questions that we can ask:

1. **Question: Who do we go to in times of need?**  
*Answer: God*
2. **Question: How can we connect with God?**  
*Answer: Through prayer*
3. **Question: What is the magic word after God has answered our prayers?**  
*Answer: We thank Him*
4. **Question: Who did the parents phone when they were worried about their daughter?**  
*Answer: The priest*
